Our office follows infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association (ADA), the U.S. centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), and Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WEISHA). We follow the activities of these agencies so that we are up-to-date on any new rulings or guidelines that may be issued. We do this to make sure that our infection control procedures are current and adhere to each agency's recommendations.

You may notice some changes when it is time for your next appointment. We have made these changes to help protect our patients and staff. You will be questioned about your health and recent travels. In order to allow social distancing between patients, there may be fewer scheduling options for your appointment. We will do our best to reduce waiting time. We will no longer use the reception area to seat our patients awaiting treatment. Instead, we ask you to wait in your car and call upon arrival of your appointment. We ask that only the patient and if appropriate only one parent/guardian come to the appointment to reduce the number of patients in our waiting room at any one time.
